



3.4. Checking the remaining battery charge.

3.5. How to Bluetooth® pair the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor to a mobile device.





Ensuring that there is no obstruction in the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor airway and the POWERbreathe compatible device has no mouthpiece attached, firmly push the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor point **A** to POWERbreathe compatible device point **B**. Firmly attach mouthpiece to POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor.

8. Troubleshooting

The POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor will not switch on.

If your POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor will not switch on, the battery may be completely flat. Follow procedures in section 3.2 to recharge the device.

Unable to pair mobile device with the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor:

- . Make sure the device is fully charged
- When pairing, make sure the mobile device is within 1m of the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor
- Enable Bluetooth® pairing on the mobile device
- Wait for the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor to turn off, leave for 15 seconds and turn back on. Restart your phone. Repeat pairing process.

Why does the POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor disconnect?

- · Smart Adaptor has very low battery, follow procedures in section 3.2 to recharge the device.
- Interference from other devices within 2.4Ghz or 5GHz bands
- . Too many apps open within your device, causing interruptions to service. Close unused apps.
- . The distance between the mobile device and POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor may be over 1 meter, try moving closer
- Low battery power on your mobile device causing the connection to be unstable
- Try restarting your device to clear memory cache built up

4. Care and Maintenance

4.1. Cleaning

Warning! Never use scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance. POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor is not suitable for dishwasher or autoclave use or any cleaning process using high temperatures (including very hot water). Do not submerge the main body of the Smart Adaptor in water.

The Smart Adaptor is not designed to be, nor supplied as, sterile.

- Make sure the USB Port Cover is plugged into the USB Port and the device is switched off before cleaning the device
- Firstly, remove the mouthpiece from the main body of the Smart Adaptor. Using the wipes provided or other suitable cleansing wipes, the mouthpiece and main body of the Smart Adaptor should be wiped down, removing any visible soiling and pay special attention to the mouthpiece area and airway
- A cleansing solution (suitable for cleansing baby bottles) can be used to clean the mouthpiece only. Remove from the Smart Adapter before submerging the mouthpiece.
- Once the device has been wiped, dry with a clean cloth. Pay particular attention to drying hard to reach places such as the airway opening. Place the device with the POWERbreathe Swirl facing upwards, in a place where air can circulate until completely dry
- When not in use, place your POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor in the supplied protective case
- · Wipe clean after each use

9. FAQ

Excessive saliva while training - what can I do?

- After each inhalation and/or exhalation pause for a few seconds to clear saliva
- . Take the device out of the mouth after inhalation and/or exhalation and swallow
- . You might want to take the trainer out of your mouth while swallowing.

My results vary a lot, is this normal?

The action of breathing is by its very nature extremely variable and difficult to control accurately. When you first start training, you may find that your results vary widely between different training sessions. As you get used to the action of breathing against a resistance with maximum effort, you should find that your results become more consistent and controllable. You may still find that there is variation from day to day, depending upon your physical condition and state of mind on a particular day, just as with any other form of exercise.

Can more than one person use the same POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor?

For hygiene reasons, we recommend that users do not share the same POWERbreathe Smart Adaptor. However, it is possible to use a bacterial viral filter like the POWERbreathe Trysafe Filter every time someone new uses the device.
